
# COLD

The Cold Carnival 2022 returned to **Hootenanny's**, Brixton, for a night of performances from our music students. With our Media team covering it, this was an event to remember.









## PERFORMING ARTS





Check out our new digital television and AI studio. The space features industry leading technology, including 4K/6K multi-camera set-ups, along with live mixing, light control and green-screen.





