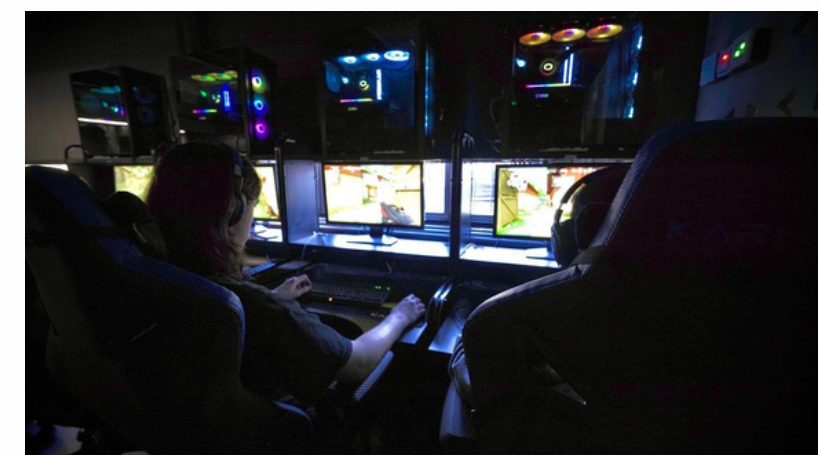

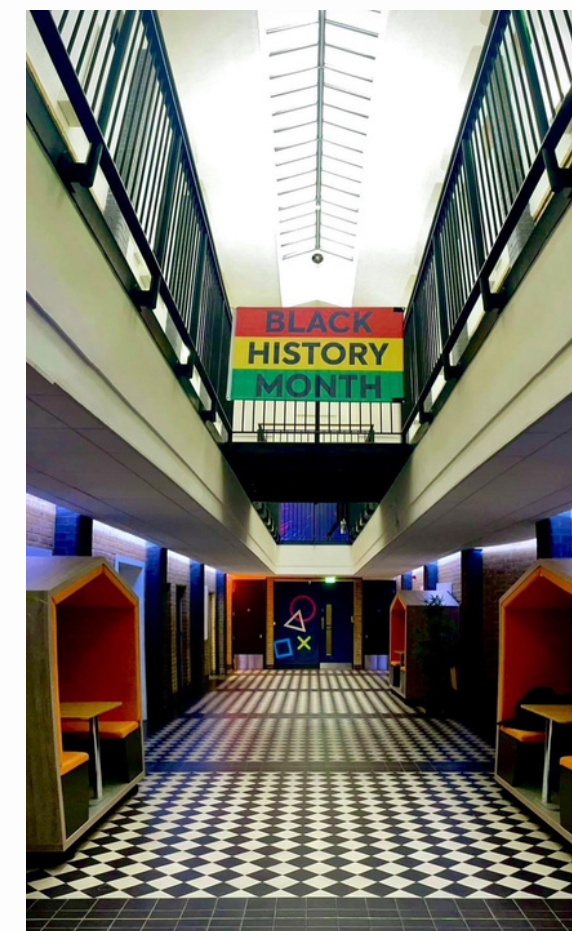

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Weekly sessions for all students with schemes of work, delivering careers and personal development education:

Level 1 & 2

Students build their personal skills learning about relationships, British values and employability skills and how they demonstrate them. They will also use psychometric testing to find out about Soft & Hard skills as well as Work Environments and Roles that may suit their personalities and skills.

Level 3

Students build on the personal development sessions and also learn about the creative arts sector and develop their careers plan. Using the same psychometric testing this is now a great tool too support with identifying progressions options and research in more details.

NATIONAL CAREER WEEK 2024

Celebration during National Careers Week for learners to experience the industry and the workplace as well as explore, network and connect with employers and HE.

VOCATIONAL SESSIONS

Fully embedded careers programme within vocational classes, including:

- Mock business set up for Level 2 and Year 1 learners, exploring the creative sector and labour market information to understand progression pathways, employability skills
- Using Labour Market Information within Classroom learning too be able to make link between Vocational Subjects and Careers Development
- Production of career tools - CVs, portfolios, showreels, professional social media, career plans
- Exploring the logistics of freelance work within the creative industry including the financial, planning and marketing aspects and many more...

1-1 CAREERS INTERVIEW

Impartial and confidential 1-1 Careers, Information, Advice and Guidance Interviews for all learners cross the BCT Study Programme.

All learners will have an individual careers interviews with the Careers Team to join up tutorials, discuss progression options and advice on Careers related topics.

All Learners will also receive an Action Plan following their Careers Interview with SMART Goals, Targets, Actions and any useful information that was discussed during the interview or the student may need

Level 3 students will have a 1-1 CEIAG with a **Level 6 Qualified Careers Advisor** to discuss progression options, planning for the future and set SMART Careers goals & targets for the academic year and beyond.

SELF DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

Learners understand their own values and aspirations and how to manage their careers during the year within SDP and throughout a dedicated Careers Term within the Programmes Scheme of Work.

Students understand how to be professional, develop a work ethic, explore employee rights Students begin to understand themselves in the workplace, how their careers will evolve over time and how to manage them .

Students learn about relationships both professional and personal and about acceptable behaviours in the wider community.

Students will also explore the themes of Sex, Religion, Grief, Mental Health and Exam Stress amongst others.

INDUSTRY PROJECTS

Throughout their time at Big Creative Training students will continuously interact with creative arts employers:

All assignment briefs are industry scenarios, with at least one delivered by an employer in their chosen industry, who will also provide feedback for the students.

Industry sessions are held in professional environments which give the learners the experience of the industry first hand within their education environment.

Industry sessions equip students with the skills to apply for industry internships or job and having the right soft & hard skills and good industry knowledge to start the roles.

Previous organisations that have partnered up with BCT for Industry briefs include Leland Records, Island Records, Fully Focused, ect.

PLANNING FOR THE FUTRUE

With a diverse student population at Big Creative Training, We naturally have students with various destination ideas and plans for next year.

University and HE

Dedicated sessions with the careers team walking the students through the UCAS application process, ensuring learners are maximising their options. Other sessions also include Student finance, life at Uni and Student Accommodation.

Apprenticeships & Training

Similarly to University and HE, The Careers Team will support student with identifying, finding, applying for opportunities as well as supporting with the Interview Process and discussing Life at Work

Other Routes

Those who have other plans or are unsure of what they want to do can move onto a mentoring programme run by the careers team to support them in their chosen destination

WORK EXPERIENCE PLACEMENTS

Drawing on Big Creative Training's employer network, we source opportunities for learners to work on projects with employers in the workplace or complete the traditional Work placements:

- Matching employer opportunities with students' aspirations
- Learners complete log books to record their learning and receive references from employers.
- Students leave with a professional network and a reference within the industry to progress their career

APPRENTICESHIPS

Achieving good outcomes for learners

Big Creative Training regards the benchmarks as a minimum standard for careers provision and sets high expectations for learners. Learners will log all careers activities on digital platform Unifrog, creating a learning journal. This will help students to understand when they are demonstrating employability skills, what they learn from industry experiences and how they can manage their own career journey.

There are several factors that make a good careers service and Big Creative Training considers multiple metrics to ensure learners are getting the best support.

Internal progression is strong within Big Creative Training, with learners progressing through the levels available internally. Progression information data is tracked carefully to ensure that the students are supported beyond their time at Big Creative Training. There is, however, a structured evaluation process for the careers programme to demonstrate impact.

Unifrog integrates with Compass+, the Department for Education's recording system. This tracks a learner's career activities throughout their school journey. The two platforms provide advanced monitoring of learners' progress for leaders and trustees.

Evaluation & Feedback

Stakeholders provide feedback on the careers programme to ensure we are meeting young people and employer needs. This is also a crucial way for the Careers team at Big Creative Training to consistently improve the service for our students and employers.
